

FINDING THE RIGHT CONTRACTOR FOR YOU

Any construction will only be as sound as the people who perform the work. A groundwater contractor should never be selected by price alone. There are a number of issues you should keep in mind when selecting a groundwater contractor.

Questions You Should Ask a Potential Contractor include:

- How long has the company been in business?
- Will the contractor supply references?
- Is the contractor a member of the state and/or national trade association?
- Will the contractor evaluate the system before making recommendations?
- Is the contractor abreast of the modern construction techniques? Does he/she regularly attend seminars or other educational events?
- Is the contractor thorough in his/her explanation of all the options available to you?
- Will the contractor provide a written estimate and a formal contract?
- Will the contractor provide a certificate of insurance before you sign a contract and before any work is begun?
- Is the contractor licensed?
